**TUCKER & MAURA'S JUST THE TIP CONTEST RULES**

THE TUCKER & MAURA'S JUST THE TIP CONTEST (THE “**CONTEST**”) WILL BE CONDUCTED IN THE PROVINCE OF ONTARIO ONLY AND SHALL BE CONSTRUED AND EVALUATED ACCORDING TO APPLICABLE CANADIAN LAW. NO PURCHASE IS NECESSARY. ENTRANTS MUST BE OF THE AGE OF MAJORITY IN THE PROVINCE OF ONTARIO OR OLDER AT THE TIME OF ENTRY. VOID IN WHOLE OR PART WHERE PROHIBITED BY LAW. ENTRY IN THIS CONTEST CONSTITUTES ACCEPTANCE OF THESE CONTEST RULES (THE “**CONTEST RULES**”).

**1. ELIGIBILITY.**

1.1 To be eligible for this Contest, an individual must:

- (a) be a legal resident of the province of Ontario; and
- (b) be of the age of majority in the province of Ontario or older at time of entry.

1.2 The following people are not eligible to enter the Contest:

- (a) Employees of Corus Radio Inc., operating as CFNY - FM (the “**Station**”) and its parent, affiliates, subsidiaries, related companies, successors and assigns (together with the Station, the “**Sponsors**”);
- (b) Any person who has been confirmed as a winner of two (2) Station administered contests within six (6) months preceding the Contest start date indicated below; and
- (c) The household members of any of the parties listed in Section (a) to (b) above.

1.3 The Sponsors shall have the right at any time to require proof of identity and/or eligibility to participate in the Contest. Failure to provide such proof may result in disqualification. All personal and other information requested by and supplied to the Sponsors for the purpose of the Contest must be truthful, complete, accurate and in no way misleading. The Sponsors reserve the right, in their sole discretion, to disqualify any entrant should such an entrant at any stage supply information that does not meet these requirements.

**2. CONTEST PERIOD.** The Contest begins at 6:00 am Eastern Time (“**ET**”) on April 1, 2026 and ends at 9:00 am ET on April 24, 2026 (the “**Contest Period**”) after which time the Contest will be closed and no further entries shall be accepted.

**3. HOW TO ENTER.**

3.1 There is no purchase necessary to enter the Contest. To enter, listen to the Station Monday to Friday during the Contest Period (except statutory holidays) between approximately 8:30 a.m. ET and 8:45a.m. ET for the cue to text (the “**Cue to Text**”) to be played. Upon hearing the Cue to Text, listeners are invited to text 416-870-3343 (the “**Contest Line**”). No entries will be accepted by any other means.

3.2 Limit of one (1) entry per person, per cellular phone number, per household per day. In the case of

multiple entries, only the first eligible entry will be considered.

- 3.3 All entries become the sole property of the Sponsors and will not be returned for any reason. Entries must be received no later than the end of the Contest Period. Entries will be declared invalid if they are late, illegible, incomplete, damaged, irregular, mutilated, forged, garbled or mechanically or electronically reproduced. Unless otherwise set out herein, no communication or correspondence will be exchanged with entrants except with those selected as a potential winner.
- 3.4 Entries received by text message shall be deemed to be submitted by the authorized account holder of the cell phone number associated with the entry. For the purpose of the Contest Rules, "authorized account holder" of a cell phone number is defined as the natural person who is assigned to a cell phone account by a cellular service provider. Any entrant may be required to provide the Sponsors with proof that they are the authorized account holder of the cell phone number associated with their entry.
- 3.5 Streaming listeners may be listening to a delayed stream of the radio signal, which may vary depending on the device on which you are listening and the speed of the internet connection. Sponsors recommend turning on a radio to the Station for the Cue to Text. Sponsors assume no liability for entrants not making timely texts to the Station due to delays in the streamed signal.

#### 4. PRIZE.

- 4.1 There are a maximum of eighteen (18) prizes (each, a "**Prize**", collectively, the "**Prizes**") available to be won by eligible participants (each, a "**Winner**", collectively, the "**Winners**") during the Contest. Each Prize consists of a cash award, with individual prize values ranging from one hundred Canadian dollars (CDN\$100) to four hundred Canadian dollars (CDN\$400), subject to the prize accumulation and reset provisions set out herein. The total cumulative value of all Prizes awarded during the Contest shall not exceed seven thousand Canadian dollars (CDN\$7,000), which amount represents the maximum total prize liability of the Station across all rounds of play, regardless of the number of Winners or the manner in which Prizes are awarded. No representation or warranty is made that this amount will be awarded or reached, in whole or in part

For greater clarity, each Cue to Text round consists of up to three (3) sequential prize opportunities. The first prize opportunity is valued at one hundred Canadian dollars (CDN\$100), the second prize opportunity is valued at two hundred Canadian dollars (CDN\$200), and the third prize opportunity is valued at four hundred Canadian dollars (CDN\$400) (the "**Third Cue Prize**"). If the Third Cue Prize is not won in a given round of play, its value may increase on a rolling basis in subsequent rounds in increments of four hundred Canadian dollars (CDN\$400), subject always to the maximum total prize value described above.

Notwithstanding the foregoing, once any Prize is awarded to a Winner on a given day of play—whether the first prize opportunity, second prize opportunity, or the Third Cue Prize—the value of the Third Cue Prize for the following day of play shall reset to four hundred Canadian dollars (CDN\$400), irrespective of whether the Third Cue Prize itself was awarded on the previous day.

For greater certainty, only one (1) Prize may be awarded per Cue to Text round, and the awarding of any Prize shall trigger the reset of the Third Cue Prize as described above..

- 4.2 Prizes will be distributed within fifty-six (56) days after each Winner has been successfully contacted and notified of their Prize and fulfilled the requirements set out herein.

## 5. PRIZE CONDITIONS.

- 5.1 Prize must be accepted as awarded and cannot be transferred, assigned, substituted or redeemed for cash, except at the sole discretion of the Sponsors. Any unused, unclaimed or declined portion of the Prize will be forfeited, have no cash value and the Sponsors shall have no obligation to provide either an alternative or value-in-kind. The Sponsors reserve the right, in their sole discretion, to substitute a prize of equal or greater value if a Prize (or any portion thereof) cannot be awarded for any reason.
- 5.2 Shipped Prizes shall not be insured and the Sponsors shall not assume any liability for lost, damaged or misdirected Prizes.

## 6. SELECTION.

6.1 A maximum of eighteen (18) Winners shall be selected as follows:

- (a) The one hundred second (102<sup>nd</sup>) texter through the Contest Line for each Cue will be chosen to play (each a “**Contestant**”);
- (b) The Contestant will hear a brief audio excerpt (the “**Song Clip**”) of a song played by on-air hosts Tucker & Maura. If the Contestant correctly identifies the title of the first song in one (1) guess, they will be declared a Winner and awarded one hundred Canadian dollars (CDN\$100).
- (c) Upon correctly identifying the first song, the Contestant may elect to continue playing by attempting to correctly identify a second song in one (1) guess. If successful, the Contestant will be declared a Winner and awarded two hundred Canadian dollars (CDN\$200).
- (d) Upon correctly identifying the second song, the Contestant may elect to continue playing by attempting to correctly identify a third song in one (1) guess. If successful, the Contestant will be declared a Winner and awarded the applicable third-song prize amount for that day of play, starting at four hundred Canadian dollars (CDN\$400) and subject to any applicable rollover increases in accordance with these Rules
- (e) If the Contestant incorrectly identifies any song during game play, the game will immediately end and no Prize will be awarded.
- (f) If the third-song prize is not won on a given day, the third-song prize amount for the next day of play will increase by four hundred Canadian dollars (CDN\$400), subject to the maximum prize limits set out in these Rules.

For illustration purposes only:

\*\*If no third-song prize is won on Monday, the third-song prize on Tuesday will increase to eight hundred Canadian dollars (CDN\$800).

\*\*If no third-song prize is won on Tuesday, the third-song prize on Wednesday will increase to one thousand two hundred Canadian dollars (CDN\$1,200).

Etc.

- (g) Once any Prize is awarded on a given day of play—whether for the first song, second song, or third song—the third-song prize amount for the following day will reset to four hundred Canadian dollars (CDN\$400), regardless of which Prize was awarded.

For greater clarity:

If a Winner is declared for either the first song, the second song, or the third song (including a rolled-over amount such as one thousand two hundred Canadian dollars (CDN\$1,200)), the third-song prize on Thursday will reset to for hundred Canadian dollars (CDN\$400).

- (h) THE SELECTED ENTRANT WILL BE NOTIFIED BY TELEPHONE AND/OR E-MAIL NO LATER THAN APRIL 27, 2026 AT 10:00A.M. ET AND MUST RESPOND WITHIN TWO (2) BUSINESS DAYS OF NOTIFICATION. Upon notification, the selected entrant must respond by telephone or e-mail (as specified in the notification) to the contact number or e-mail address provided no later than the indicated deadline set out in the Contest Rules and/or the notification. If the selected entrant does not respond accordingly, they will be disqualified and will not receive a Prize and another entrant may be selected in the Sponsors' sole discretion until such time as an entrant satisfies the terms set out herein. The Sponsors are not responsible for the failure for any reason whatsoever of a selected entrant to receive notification or for the Sponsors to receive a selected entrant's response.
- (i) If, as a result of an error relating to the entry process, drawing or any other aspect of the Contest, there are more selected entrants than contemplated in these Contest Rules, there will be a random draw amongst all eligible Prize claimants after the Contest's closing date to award the correct number of Prizes.

7. **RELEASE.** Potential Winner will be required to execute a legal agreement and release (“**Release**”) that confirms potential Winner’s: (i) eligibility for the Contest and compliance with these Contest Rules; (ii) acceptance of the Prize as offered; (iii) release of each of the Sponsors and each of their employees, directors, officers, suppliers, agents, sponsors, administrators, licensees, representatives, advertising, media buying and promotional agencies (collectively, the “**Releasees**”) from any and all liability for any loss, harm, damages, cost or expense arising out of participation in the Contest, participation in any Contest-related activity or the acceptance, use, or misuse of any Prize, including but not limited to costs, injuries, losses related to personal injuries, death, damage to, loss or destruction of property, rights of publicity or privacy, defamation, or portrayal in a false light, or from any and all claims of third parties arising therefrom; and (iv) grant to the Sponsors of the unrestricted right, in the Sponsors’ collective or individual discretion, to produce, reproduce, display, publish, convert, post, serve, broadcast, exhibit, distribute, adapt and otherwise use or re-use the Winner’s name, statements, image, likeness, voice and biography, in any and all media now known or hereafter devised, in connection with the Contest and the promotion and exploitation thereof. The executed Release must be returned within seven (7) business days of the date indicated on the accompanying letter of notification or the verification as a Winner or the selected entrant will be disqualified and the Prize forfeited.

8. **INDEMNIFICATION BY ENTRANT.** By entering the Contest, each entrant releases, indemnifies and holds Releasees harmless from any and all liability for any injuries, loss or damage of any kind to the entrant or any other person, including personal injury, exposure to the COVID-19 virus, death, or property damage, resulting in whole or in part, directly or indirectly, from (a) their participation in the Contest or any Contest-related activity; (b) the acceptance, use, or misuse of any Prize; or (c) any breach of the Contest Rules. Each entrant agrees to fully indemnify the Releasees from any and all claims made by third parties relating to the entrant’s participation in the Contest, without limitation.

9. **LIMITATION OF LIABILITY.** The Sponsors assume no responsibility or liability for lost, late, unintelligible/illegible, falsified, damaged, misdirected or incomplete entries, notifications, responses, replies or any Release, or for any telephone, hardware or technical malfunctions that may occur, including but not limited to malfunctions that may affect the transmission or non-transmission of an entry. The Sponsors are not responsible for any incorrect or inaccurate information, whether caused by any of the equipment or programming associated with or utilized in the Contest or by any technical or human error which may occur in the administration of the Contest. The Sponsors assume no responsibility or liability in the event that the Contest cannot be conducted as planned for any reason, including reasons beyond the control of the Sponsors, such as tampering, unauthorized intervention, fraud, technical failures, or corruption of the administration, security, fairness, integrity or proper conduct of this Contest.
10. **CONDUCT.** By participating in the Contest, each entrant is deemed to have executed and agrees to be bound by the Contest Rules, which will be posted at the contest microsite and made available throughout the Contest Period. Each entrant further agrees to be bound by the decisions of the Sponsors, which shall be final and binding in all respects. The Sponsors reserve the right, in their sole discretion, to disqualify any entrant found to be: (a) violating the Contest Rules; (b) tampering or attempting to tamper with the entry process or the operation of the Contest (c) violating the terms of service, conditions of use and/or general rules or guidelines of any Station property or service; and/or (d) acting in an unsportsmanlike or disruptive manner, or with intent to annoy, abuse, threaten or harass the Sponsors or any other person. CAUTION: ANY ATTEMPT TO DELIBERATELY UNDERMINE THE LEGITIMATE OPERATION OF THE CONTEST MAY BE A VIOLATION OF CRIMINAL AND CIVIL LAWS. SHOULD SUCH AN ATTEMPT BE MADE, THE SPONSORS RESERVE THE RIGHT TO SEEK REMEDIES AND DAMAGES TO THE FULLEST EXTENT PERMITTED BY LAW, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO CRIMINAL PROSECUTION.
11. **PRIVACY / USE OF PERSONAL INFORMATION.**
- 11.1 By entering the Contest, each entrant expressly consents to Corus/Station \*use Station if Contest with no Sponsor\* and its third-party agents and service providers, to collect, use, store, and share any personal information submitted by entrant to enter the Contest, such as name, age of majority confirmation, and contact information, as applicable, only for the purpose of implementing, administering, and fulfilling the Contest as described in these Contest Rules, and in accordance with Corus'/Station's \*use Station if Contest with no Sponsor\* Privacy Policy, available at <http://www.corusent.com/privacy-policy>.
- 11.2 Each Winner further consents that the Station may broadcast, publish, disseminate and otherwise use a Winner's name, city/town/village and province/territory of residence, image and/or voice in connection with any promotion and/or publicity purposes without further compensation to Winner.
- 11.3 No communication unrelated to the Contest, commercial or otherwise, will be sent to the entrant unless the entrant otherwise expressly agrees to receive further communications from Sponsors.
12. **INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY.** All intellectual property, including but not limited to trade-marks, trade names, logos, designs, promotional materials, web pages, source code, drawings, illustrations, slogans and representations is owned by the Sponsors and/or their affiliates. All rights are reserved. Unauthorized copying or use of any copyrighted material or intellectual property without the express written consent of its owner is strictly prohibited.
13. **TERMINATION.** The Sponsors reserve the right, in their sole discretion, to terminate the Contest, in whole or in part, and/or modify, amend or suspend the Contest, and/or the Contest Rules in any way,

at any time, for any reason without prior notice.

- 14. LAW.** These are the official Contest Rules. The Contest is subject to applicable federal, provincial and municipal laws and regulations. The Contest Rules are subject to change without notice in order to comply with any applicable federal, provincial and municipal laws or the policy of any other entity having jurisdiction over the Sponsors. All issues and questions concerning the construction, validity, interpretation and enforceability of the Contest Rules or the rights and obligations as between the entrant and the Sponsors in connection with the Contest shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the province of Ontario without giving effect to any choice of law or conflict of law rules or provisions that would cause the application of any other jurisdiction's laws.
- 15. DISCREPANCY.** In the event of any discrepancy or inconsistency between the terms and conditions of the Contest Rules and disclosures or other statements contained in any Contest-related materials, including but not limited to the Contest entry form, or point of sale, television, print or online advertising, the terms and conditions of the Contest Rules shall prevail, govern and control.
- 16. SOCIAL MEDIA.** This Contest is in no way sponsored, endorsed or administered by any social media platforms on which the Contest may have been promoted and/or publicized. Any questions, comments or complaints regarding the Contest must be directed to Station.
